Thank you for attending the Christmas Fayre on December 5th. The fayre was very enjoyable and exceptionally well organised by the Holywell School Fundraisers. You will see from the enclosed note that £2189 was raised for the benefit of the children. I would like to thank the HSF for organising this fantastic event.

Thank you once again for your generosity with fundraising for BBC Children in Need. You will probably have heard that Pudsey Bear came to visit Holywell to say a special thank you to the children!

I hope you enjoyed the Christmas productions. Staff and children worked incredibly hard to make these enjoyable for you. Once again I would like to thank you for your donations, over £273 was collected by the children on the doors and the refreshments raised over £134 which means that over £400 has gone into School Fund. This is a very generous amount of money, and I appreciate your generosity very much.

School Milk - for parents of children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2
