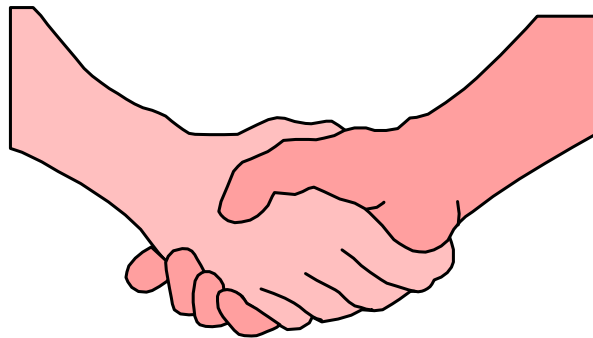

## THE AIMS OF THE SCHOOL

Our main aim is to enable all children to achieve their full potential in *all* aspects of school life - both academically and socially.

- Encourage children to work hard to develop enquiring minds, thereby fulfilling their potential.
- Encourage self-discipline, good manners and a sense of responsibility so that everyone can play a part in creating and maintaining a happy and well ordered school of which they can be proud.
- Have clear aims and learning objectives.
- Make every effort to ensure that school policies are understood and followed by staff, children and parents.
- Inform you of any concerns we may have regarding your child.
- Discuss your child's progress at parent evenings, or by prior arrangement.
- Expect children to show mutual respect to adults and peers and to foster an understanding of their own culture and that of others.
- Have a clearly stated, published Behaviour Policy detailing expectations, rewards and sanctions.
- Follow the principles outlined in our Confidentiality Policy.

## HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

### For the Parents/Carers:

I/we will try to:

- Encourage my child to do their best at all times.
- Let the school know about any problems which might affect work or behaviour.
