Dear Parents

Drinks, Snacks and Milk!

The school is very proud of its healthy eating policy which has worked very successfully in the past. Our policy is that, at breaktime, children have a snack of fruit or vegetable but **no** sweets, crisps or chocolate. Children will be given time to have their snack during the morning. We are participating in the Governments scheme of fruit provision for 5-7 year olds. We ask that lunchboxes are not packed with too many sweet things. Sweets are not acceptable. Drinks should not be fizzy pop.

During the Autumn Term all children in Reception are entitled to free milk on a daily basis. If you wish your child to have milk you must sign and return the consent form that will be sent to you in September. This entitlement is reviewed termly (Spring and Summer Terms). If your child has had their 5th birthday before they return to school at the beginning of each term they will need to pay for milk. Letters will be sent out at the beginning of the Spring and Summer Term giving details.

If you do not want your child to have milk, please supply your child with a healthy fruit drink of your choice.

If you have any concerns or queries, please see your child's class Teacher.
